

PowerPoint Presentations

As part of the Business Communications Course, students will be required to present two topics (subject matter to be assigned) orally, using Microsoft PowerPoint.

This assignment is intended to sharpen student's skills in the following competency areas:

- Research data, generate ideas and present information
- Give oral presentations confidently and comfortably
- Gain understanding of the assigned topic

Presentations guidelines are as follows:

- PowerPoint must be more than 5 slides (no maximum – use as many as you need to convey your topic)
- Total presentation length is expected to be between 10-20 minutes. If you feel you need more than 20 minutes, that is completely acceptable, but please let me know – the time allowed is just a guideline in order for me to lesson plan around your topic. Although I will be watching the clock, if you have fully explored and explained your topic in 9 minutes, this will be considered sufficient. If you find yourself short on material – expand your topic and do more research!
- Please prepare materials to hand out prior to your presentation in order for your fellow students to take notes. The topics you cover are part of the curriculum, and will be tested.
- Please leave time for questions or comments at the end of your presentation. Be prepared to entertain any that arise.
- The text is just a starting point. In order to achieve full marks, you **MUST** add to the material provided. Include current topics, such as:
 - o The impact of technology on your topic
 - o How does your topic appeal to/affect the different generations in the workplace
 - o Do shifting Canadian demographics have an impact on your subject?
 - o Recent news stories regarding your topic
 - o Trends in business that pertain to your topic
 - o Any others you feel relevant!
- You may add other presentation materials, for example handouts, brochures, pamphlets, that will assist you to convey your topic. They are not to be added extraneously, but in order to supplement your presentation. (example: If your topic was polling your customers, perhaps collect a customer survey card from a restaurant, or explain how to use the Survey Monkey website)
- Cite your sources – proper citations will be discussed in class prior to the first presentation
