What information do we collect?

We collect information from you when you fill out a form online or on person. This information is kept protected via current industry-standard information security methods.

When requesting more information on our website, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your name, email, address, mailing address or phone number.

What do we use your information for?

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

- To send you information you requested
- To send periodic emails

The email address you provide will only be used to send you information and updates pertaining to the information you requested. Note, if at any time you would like to unsubscribe from our emails, you will be able to do so by replying that you no longer wish to receive information from us.

How do we protect your information?

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information when you enter, submit or access your personal information. The database which holds your personal information is encrypted using modern software encryption techniques and transported using Secure Socket Layer (SSL). This data can only be accessed by approved staff.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

We do not sell, trade or otherwise transfer your personally identifiable information to outside parties. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies or protect ours or others' rights, property or safety. However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising or other uses.
